Prothane Motion Control highly recommends this and all our polyure hane suspension kits be installed by a qualified automotive technician.

## Kit #16-201 FRONT CONTROL ARM BUSHINGS

- Remove the lower control arm from the vehicle. We recommend you remove one side at a time. In the event you
  get confused or lost you can refer back to the other side for help.
- 2) Remove the rear bushing with aluminum bracket from the control arm. Be sure to mark the direction of the bracket before removal.
- 3) Press the original bushing out of the aluminum bracket using a hydraulic press and the appropriately sized spacers. Be careful not to damage the bracket in the process.
- 4) Press the original bushing out of the front of the control arm using a hydraulic press and the appropriately sized spacers. Be careful not to damage the arm in the process.
- 5) Deburr and wipe clean any debris from the inside of the arm and aluminum bracket.
- 6) Install the new polyurethane bushing 64357 into the front side of the arm using plenty of Prothane Super Grease. (See Fig. 1)
- 7) Grease and install the new steel inner sleeve 60941 into the polyurethane bushings.
- 8) Install the new polyurethane bushing 64358, 64359 and sleeve 60940 into the aluminum bracket using plenty of Prothane™ Super Grease. (See Fig. 2)
- 9) Grease the outer face of all bushings and reassemble arm and bracket.
- 10) Install complete arm assembly on vehicle and torque all fasteners to factory specifications.
